PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Anna Gigantino joined the European Union Agency for railways in early 2014 as Head of the Interoperability Unit. She is now leading the Agency's Analysis and Monitoring Unit since July 2018.

She formerly worked in the European Commission from 2006 to 2014, first as Project Officer for new and renewable energies in DG Research, then as Policy Officer for railway interoperability in DG Move. She participated since 2011 in the works which led to the adoption of the Fourth Railway Package.

From 2000 to 2006, she has been Planning and Coordination Manager and Deputy Project Director in the AEIF (Association européenne pour l'interopérabilité ferroviaire), based in Paris and Brussels.

From 1993 to 2000 she was Principal Inspector for the Italian Railway Infrastructure Manager (RFI), dealing mainly with track maintenance and standardisation matters.

From 1991 to 1993 she acquired direct experience in the field of research, innovation and patenting.
