Minutes of the Meeting

1. Opening

Karel Van Gils (EU-RAIL) welcomed the members to the 5th FRMCS subgroup meeting.

Karel announced that Mario Sela (DB) is appointed as WG2 coordinator. Mario introduced himself.

2. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting

The MoM on the 13th of November meeting approved.

Actions in the MoM were taken and finalised with the exception of the KoM of the WG1, that action is pending on the appointment of the WG1 coordinator.

3. Outcome UIC conference

Karel introduced the relevance on the UIC conference. He explained that the deployment group was introduced in the UIC conference. It was agreed to upload in the SharePoint the UIC conference presentations¹. [Action: upload in the SharePoint the public presentations used on the UIC conference]

During the discussions, participants emphasized the tight time schedule and the need to strategize the best approach to be prepared for the development of FRMCS after 2027, aiming to achieve the target of GSM-R end of life in 2035. It was agreed that capacity and timelines of both IM and RU to deploy FRMCS should be considered.

Martin Schroeder (ERA) announced that the Technical Opinion on the version 2 of the FRMCS specifications will be published by the end of 2024 with an addendum end of Q1 2025.

4. State of play FRMCS subgroup

Karel announced that Group 2 candidates had applied for the position of Programme Manager and Supervisor of FRMCS Deployment Group. Two additional candidates are expected to apply during this week. A decision on the formal appointment will be made in accordance with the published process. It is expected that the program manager/Management team will be appointed early next year.

5. State of play working groups

Karel provided an update on the status of the WG1, noting that no one had been appointed as the coordinator of WG1. Michael Mikulandra (UNIFE) announced that UNIFE had potential candidates to propose in the following days. It was agreed to await the appointment of the WG1 coordinator and to launch the KoM after Christmas. [Action: UNIFE to propose a candidate to coordinate WG1]

Wawrzyniec Perschke (DG MOVE) informed that the EC received the report on availably of FRMCS products. It is a short report that includes the information on the availably of FRMCS products, which is dependent on the availability of the FRMCS specifications.

Alfonso Lorenzo introduced the proposal of dedicated Working Groups to lead the activity where more WG's are involved (see the meeting presentation). The proposal was agreed [Agreement].
