


TRansformation of AViation and rAilway solutions to Wards ntegration and SynergiEs



Travel Wise strengthens multimodal situation awareness and coordination, focusing on Short term and Day of operations horizons, minimising disruptions through collaboration.

Travel Wise is a multimodal innovation project for the aviation and railway (and maritime) sectors, focusing on multimodal common situation awareness and increased

coordination between air/rail/waterborne transport modes to facilitate multimodal journeys.

Travel Wise shifts traffic management modes to multimodal isolated from orchestration by developing a framework for: i) information sharing across air, rail, maritime, ii) collaborative informed decision-making in both normal and disrupted conditions, and iii) optimising the passenger experience.


The Travel Wise project considers 3 operational contexts, that will be studied withinin 3 scenarios:

- 1) A city pair 2) An international hub

User Requirements Elicitation


A mixed top-down and bottom-up approach combining desk research and user workshops to map roles, tasks, information flows, and disruptionmanagement needs.



Results of the User Requirements Elicitation

Multimodal integration: TW is expected to Information coordination: TW is expected to enable interoperable data exchange and deliver a shared operational picture with planning across air-rail role-specific updates to support aligned decisions.

Sudden disruptions: TW is expected to Timetable synchronisation: TW is expected to cross-mode alerts and align schedules to protect connections.

> Data sharing: TW is expected to enforce GDPR-compliant governance for trusted exchange.

> Sustainability: TW is expected to prioritise rail-first options and optimise flows to reduce congestion and emissions.
